

**GALT IRRIGATION DISTRICT  
Regular Board Meeting Minutes  
June 10, 2025**

**Opening:**

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman VanWarmerdam at 8:30 a.m. at the Galt Irrigation District office, Herald, California.
2. Members present were Leo VanWarmerdam, John Mulrooney, Tony Merola and Cameron Crouch. Also present were Teresa Flewellyn, Tish Espinosa, Gary Silva Jr., Alexis Silva, Mike Wackman and Wendy Sparrowk.
3. Public Comment – Gary Silva presented an appeal for parcels owned by Gary Silva Sr. that were charged a base fee without a well on the property. Item will be on next meeting agenda.

**Consent Items:**

1. The minutes for the May 13, 2025 Regular Board meeting were reviewed. The Board reviewed the current bills and Treasurer's Report. The most current assessment distribution, which will be recorded in next months meeting, was reviewed. Motion was made by Director Mulrooney to approve the Minutes, Treasurer's Report and monthly bills; motion second by Director Crouch. The bills were as follows:

3. Groundwater Management Report –
  - a. CGA update – Director Crouch prepared a summary of the last CGA meeting. There was discussion on the tunnel project and resignation of Lindsey Liebig Carter.
  - b. DWR Stream Gage grant update –RFP's are being worked on and the process leading up to actual field work starting in October was reviewed.
  - c. Wackman Consulting Report- Mike Wackman is looking at ways to get water down Dry Creek for winter recharge (December -April). Discussion was held reviewing the discharge water from fish farm on Alta Mesa Road that used to flow into Denier property but now pools in Rocha property and flows into Dry Creek. Chairman VanWarmerdam will contact owner of fish farm. Mike reviewed State Water Board and Regional Water Quality Board stipulations for water used for recharge projects and permitting. Reviewed OHWD recharge project that is a controlled test using groundwater to recirculate to test the recharge.
  - d. Assessment appeal – John/Laura Mulrooney – Motion was made by Director Crouch to approve the Mulrooney appeal for \$1355.50; motion second by Director Merola; Director Mulrooney abstained from vote.
4. Other Business-
  - a. Walker Estates – Nothing to report.
  - b. GID Draft Budget 2025/26 – The budget for fiscal year 2025/26 was reviewed. Motion was made by Director Mulrooney to adopt the draft budget of \$245,174 for fiscal year 2025/26; motion second by Director Crouch.
