

GALT IRRIGATION DISTRICT
Regular Board Meeting Minutes
May 12, 2026

Opening:

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman VanWarmerdam at 6:05 p.m. at the Galt Irrigation District office, Herald, California.
2. Members present were Leo VanWarmerdam, John Mulrooney, Pat Kirby, Tony Merola and Cameron Crouch. Also present was Wendy Sparrowk.
3. Public Comment – Nothing to report.

Consent Items:

1. The minutes for the April 14, 2026 Regular Board meeting were reviewed. The Board reviewed the current bills and Treasurer's Report. Motion was made by Director Mulrooney to approve the Minutes, Treasurer's Report and monthly bills; motion second by Director Crouch. The bills were as follows:

Information/Action Items:

1. Administrator's Report – The November election was discussed. Sign up dates are July 13-August 7. The County asked GID to add wordage for ties to the approved resolution. Motion was made by Director Crouch that all ties will be broken by lot; motion second by Director Merola.
2. Safety Report – Nothing to report.
3. Groundwater Management Report –
 - a. CGA update - Lindsey Carter – Discussed the CGA budget of which CGA approved the deficit of \$186.50 from GID last year. Discussed the importance of correcting data gaps and incorrect readings. Discussed City of Galt new management and meeting with Lindsey to discuss data gaps.
 - b. DWR Stream Gage grant update –Tasks seem to be moving forward and installation/running are expected by October. Indian influence has lessened.
 - c. Wild Eye Pilot Program- The subscription fee per well is \$225/annually and there is a warranty period on equipment. Linsdey sent out bid requests for a pilot program and has had very little response. Directors will vote on contractor at next meeting.
 - d. Wackman Consulting Report- Nothing to report.
4. Other Business-
 - a. Walker Estates – Nothing to report.
 - b. Other – Procurement Policy- Directors reviewed a sample from OHWD. It was decided to get permission from OHWD to use this policy as a template for GID and adopt the policy at next meeting.
5. Director Comments – Chairman VanWarmerdam talked to Ken Beer about periodic water sample testing for GID GSA to accumulate data necessary for the GSPlan. Discussed getting Dry Creek and Laguna Creek water samples and culvert work on Alta Mesa Road.
