**Opening:**

1. The meeting was called to order by Chairman VanWarmerdam at 8:30 a.m. at the Galt Irrigation District office, Herald, California.

3. Groundwater Management Report –
  - a. CGA update – The City of Galt presented to CGA that the city water consumption is less than in 2014 by using a tiered charging system. Brittany was released from her contract and Lindsey is acting as manager. GW monitoring will be done this week and the annual report can be found online. Directors discussed the possible impact on irrigated land assessments with the removal of grapes in the District.
  - b. DWR Stream Gage grant update – Directors reviewed the stream gages and combining the contracts with SHRCD with SHRCD contracting with DWR for the combined contracts. This will be presented at the SHRCD meeting on April 15<sup>th</sup>. Motion was made by Director Mulrooney to approve combining the 2 GID stream gage contracts with the SHRCD gage awards and SHRCD will contract with DRW for the combined contracts; motion second by Director Kirby.
  - c. Wackman Consulting Report-Mike discussed finding areas along Laguna Creek and Badger Creek for preliminary recharge or flooding for a state program available that Sac County has utilized in other areas. Directors discussed possible land parcels.
