3. Groundwater Management Report -

A. GSA Landowner Agreement-The Landowner Agreement for well monitoring was reviewed and discussed. Questions were asked of John Lowrie and Tom Goehring about testing for water quality and GW levels. There may be a public well already being monitored for both quality and levels within GID that could be used. GID as a GSA wants to include any factors that would help determine if the groundwater is being managed responsibly while also making landowners feel comfortable in their participation in the monitoring program. Motion was made by Director Mulrooney to revise the draft landowner agreement to give landowners a choice of having levels and quality monitored or levels only from their wells; motion second by Director Kirby.

B. Grant for Well Monitoring report – Mike Wackman is working on the grant for well monitoring. The Directors feel like all 3 Ag districts could benefit from sharing a person to monitor.
